Foreword

"Moments & More" is Christine's second major solo exhibition following 2018's "A Moment in Time" exhibition.

Whereas the 2018 exhibition was a retrospective of Christine's work spanning a period of 20 years (1998 – 2018), "Moments & More" focusses on her more recent work. With a few exceptions, most pictures were taken between 2017 and 2019.

Christine will donate 50% of the proceeds of this exhibition, including the sales of this catalogue, to the Singapore Cancer Society.

Moments & More

General introduction

As I emphasized for my first exhibition: I am not a professional photographer. Photography remains one of my most loved hobbies and I take my camera outdoors as often as possible.

Since the last exhibition – prompted through my participation in various photo competitions – I have also started to experiment with more arranged photography like for example still lives. I will showcase a few examples in the exhibition.

I also experimented with different kinds of photo-software. I found it very useful for the experimental photography. For outdoor and nature photography, I still prefer to keep the picture as 'natural' as possible, rather creating effects through photographic techniques than afterwards adding to the picture.

Overview

The exhibition focuses on the beauty I see, be it in nature or in a detail catching my attention in the city.

While doing some work for a photo competition, I also started to experiment with still lives. However, I did not want to create the traditional re-creation of an oil painting-like still life. This led to my experimenting with minimalism and objects I collected during my ventures into nature.

- **Moments & More in the City:** This section showcases my love for abstraction, different perspectives and details. Most of the pictures were taken when showing around visitors or when I take out my bicycle to discover Singapore.
- Moments & More in Nature: Maybe because I grew up in the countryside, I really love nature. Being in nature instantly calms me down, relaxes me. In Singapore, I take my bicycle to discover

ever new areas, and my camera is always with me. Through these excursions I have, for example, discovered the beauty of the sunrays playing in the foliage of Bukit Brown Cemetery or the ever-changing lotus ponds in various parks across the city. The displayed pictures, of course, include pictures taken during my travels in Europe and Australia.

- **Experimental Moments & More:** The pictures in this section are the result of experimenting with different kinds of photosoftware. In fact, I used two different programs to create the effect shown in the displayed pictures.
- **Still Lives:** I have started to participate in various photo competitions. One of the competitions was titled "Artistic Still Life". The examples given to me all looked strikingly like an oil painting. And I did not want to create a photographic version of a painting. So, I created still lives closer to my photographic philosophy keeping it simple, minimalistic even.

Selection and arrangement of the pictures

For this exhibition, I focussed on my more recent body of work: With very few exceptions the exhibited photographs were taken during the last three years, in fact with a very strong focus on my work in 2019.

And again – as during my past exhibition – the pictures I chose are not necessarily the 'most perfect' but the ones which I think best fit into a topic and / or a group.

The selection process was supported by my most helpful critic, by my husband. Without his help I would still be in the process of selecting.

About Christine Nagel

Christine grew up in Metzingen, a small town, nestled at the foot of the Swabian Alb, near Stuttgart, South-Western Germany. While growing up in the countryside kindled Christine's love for nature and the outdoors, her father's business travels very early on started a keen interest for the world beyond the Swabian Alb, particularly China.


An economist by background, Christine also studied Chinese and spent a year at Fudan University, Shanghai, to attend Chinese language courses and lectures in Economics as part of a postgraduate scholarship. As the experiences made during the year in China were very captivating and fascinating, Christine decided to one day come back.

This happened in May 1997, when Christine was sent by her company – she meanwhile had started a career in the insurance industry – to Shanghai to help set up their life insurance company and later to head their Shanghai Representative Office. Christine and her husband, Boris, stayed four and a half years in Shanghai before being posted to Singapore in October 2001. Initially this was meant to be for a year or two.

After 18 years, Christine and Boris are still in Singapore. Both liked Singapore very much so they decided to stay. They have put down their roots in Singapore also to give their two children, Max, now 19 years old, and Ida, 16 years old, some stability during their schooling.

After 25 years in the financial industry, Christine decided to try out something else and spend more time pursuing her other passions: photography, sports, travelling, food, and gardening. This resulted in several projects, one of which is this exhibition.




